



Seneca County Medical Society Scholarship

The Seneca County Medical Society Scholarship is a grant in the amount of \$1,000.00 that will be awarded annually, at the discretion of the selection committee. The scholarship will be awarded without regard to race, color, religion, sex, handicap, familial status, or national origin.

Applicants must:

- Be a graduating senior of a high school located in Seneca County
- Be enrolled in an accredited educational institution
- Declare intent to pursue or be enrolled in a healthcare or medical related program
- Complete and submit an application provided by the Seneca County Medical Society before Friday, May 12, 2017. (The applications are available in the guidance office.)

The following information must accompany the application:

- ♦ Two recommendations
- ♦ A copy of the student's most recent transcript
- ♦ A written essay that addresses the following topics
 1. What inspired you to choose your career path?
 2. What attribute do you feel you possess that will help you reach your goal?
 3. What educational resources are you using to develop your career?

The selection committee will award the scholarship based on the applicant's academic achievement, community involvement, recommendations, and written essay. The selection committee's decision in awarding this scholarship is final.

The selection committee will be comprised of the Seneca County Medical Society President or designee and the Vice Presidents of Academic Affairs of both Heidelberg University and Tiffin University, or their designees.

Application forms are available from the guidance counselors at all Seneca County High Schools. **Applications must be submitted by Friday, May 12, 2017.** The Seneca County Medical Society plans to award the Scholarship at its June 20, 2017 meeting.
